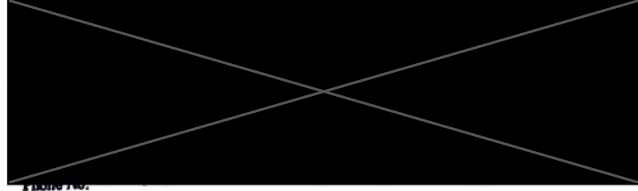
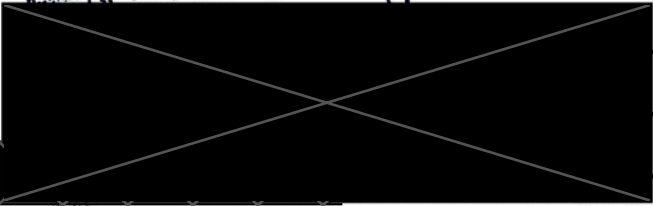

live videos describing the attack. He was not present during the attack -  
he was in the parking lot of the First School Administration Building  
the entire time. In his Facebook posts he has been repeatedly asking  
his "followers" to "come for" me and "come after" me to "show  
your support" for Danielle Green and justify her assault on me. The justifications  
include pointing out my sexual orientation and/or gender identity. (cont.)
